### Information search process





## Identification of information needs

How recent the information should be?

- What type and what kind of information do you need?
- What format of information do you need?
- What languages will you use in your search?
- How much information do you need?
- How much time do you have for information search?





## Keywords

- Identification of keywords based on the topic and aspects related with the topic.
- Alternative terms, synonyms.
- Context is relevant while searching for information.

Encyclopedias

Dictionaries

Thesaurus

THESAURUS – a dictionary of synonyms consisting of a comprehensive list of subjects concerning which information may be retrieved by using the proper key terms

Institutional or joint library ecatalogues

Databases of institutional publications, theses and dissertations Subscribed research databases, e.g., ScienceDirect, EBSCO, SpringerLINK, etc.

Open Access resources of research information, e.g., Directory of Open Access Journals, HighwirePress, etc. Search engines of research information, e.g., Google Scholar, RefSeek, etc.



## Evaluation of search results

### Search results selection criteria:

- Relevance
- Novelty
- Variety

- of information
- Quantitity
- Quality

### Information quality criteria:

- Reliability
- Objectivity
- Authorship of the source
- Publisher
- The aim of publishing
- List of references





- It is impossible to find all relevant information resources. It is very important to keep balance between quantity and quality.
- There is no right solution, best search tool or the only keyword. You can change your search strategy.
- The main search principles (choosing keywords, search tools and resources) can be applied for searching in any information resource.
- Write down selected keywords, search tools etc. Save the relevant documents and information about them, make notes.
- You can always ask a librarian for advice.

## Users are allowed:

□To use e-resources in your projects according to Copyright and Related Rights Law.

To use (download / print / save) e-resources in small quantities and only for personal needs. In one session you can download not more than:

- 2 articles from one issue of the e-journal;
- 20% of one e-book.

<u>Science Direct E-Books</u> – e-books published by Elsevier (more than 400 books of the subscribed 700 belongs to the *Physical Sciences and Engineering* collection)

<u>Ebrary</u> – Engineering&Technology collection includes more than 6800 e-books.

<u>Ebooks o EBSCOhost</u> – Engineering&Technology collection includes about 8000 e-books

<u>Springer LINK E-Books</u> – access to Chemistry and Material science and Engineering collections published in 2005-2007 (book list) and access to Engineering collection published in 2010-2014 (book list)

<u>Academic Search Complete</u> - a database in EBSCO group with more than 9000 journals including engineering sciences.

<u>ScienceDirect</u> - multi-disciplinary database, including more than 800 journals on physical sciences and engineering.

<u>Oxford</u> <u>Journals</u> - multi-disciplinary database published by Oxford University Press. Subscribed journal list

<u>SAGE journals</u> - scientific journals not only on Social Sciences and Humanities but also on *Computer Science*, *Engineering* and *Material Science* too. Subscribed journal list.

<u>SpringerLINK journals</u> – multi-disciplinary database, including Chemistry and Material Sciences, Engineering, Computer Science, Professional and Applied Computing collections.<sup>22</sup>
